## Resonating Images from Peru Artist Bios

### Hans Heinrich Brüning (1848–1928)

Hans Heinrich Brüning, also known as Hinrich and in Peru as Enrique, was a North German engineer, self-taught researcher and photographer. He was among the first to document the cultural history of his adopted home in northern Peru in depth. His photographic body of work comprises of more than 2,000 images on over 4,300 media, now preserved at the MARKK. Brüning's visual documentation of landscapes, archaeology, architecture, festivals, customs, everyday life and the local communities remains of great importance to the region's cultural identity today.

### Marystela Camacho (b. 1994)

Marystela Camacho is a Peruvian photographer and visual artist from Cajamarca. Her work brings together contemporary photography, archival research, nature and textile intervention to address historical tensions and forgotten narratives. Her works were presented at the international photography festival "Ver Voir" 2024 and in the 4th and 5th editions of the analog photography fair "La Otra Luz". In the same year, her solo exhibition "Tramas Mestizas" was on view, and she was recognized as a "Nuevo Talento" (emerging talent) by the international platform Datarte.

### Enzo Miguel Matute (b. 1984)

Enzo Miguel Matute was born in Cascas, Peru. In his ceramic works, he explores cultural identity and alienation, combining contemporary iconic references with archaeological fictions. In 2010, Matute was selected for "EROGINA", the IV Biennial of Erotic Art in Santa Fe, Argentina. In 2014 and 2018, he was a finalist in the Franco-Peruvian visual arts competition "Pasaporte para un Artista" in Lima. His photo-ceramic work "Cesar Vallejo" is included in the book series "Arte y Tesoros del Perú 50 años. Nuevas Miradas". In 2025, his works were shown at the Palacio de los Barrantes-Cervantes in Trujillo and, in 2026, at the Casa de la Provincia - Diputación Provincial in Seville.
